Eaton is one of the leading electrical, power generation, and automotive technology companies in the world. When they decided to assist a strategic supplier in identifying cost out measures they chose to recommend consulting with BridgePort Group to help bring substantial cost savings through re-engineering and new efficiencies.

Supplier Background

Aubert & Duval (A&D) provides advanced metallurgical solutions in the form of parts or long products required for projects in the most demanding industries including aerospace, energy, industrial tools, steel, motor racing, and medical among others.

A&D's core activity is developing, melting, and hot processing super alloys, aluminum and titanium which is needed to meet their clients' stronger specifications. The company has provided Eaton and similar manufacturers around the globe with steel and other metals for use in multiple vehicle applications including transmissions and engine valves as well as various aerospace and military defense applications.

Business Challenge

Due to the high number of steel suppliers resulting from recent acquisitions, Eaton experienced redundancy in services, unreliable forecasts, quality discrepancies, and high administrative costs.

Additionally, the Eaton plant in Kearney, NE occasionally resorted to premium freight to get material in time to reduce the likelihood of production disruptions.

La Havre France based A&D used a third-party freight forwarder in Detroit, MI and a subleased warehouse in Romeoville, IL and multiple carriers for drayage of small quantities of steel. Contract disputes and poor forecasts created poor supplier relationship and customer dissatisfaction.

How BridgePort Helped

BPG was called upon to address A&D's challenge of meeting its 15% cost reduction effort; and 92% on-time delivery.

The firm's DDP Model was instrumental in assisting A&D with forecasting, FOB shipment, and predictable consumption to improve min/max levels and eliminate premium freight. The results were:

- stabilized volumes
- reduced days on hand inventory
- negotiated rates with A&D and carriers
- merged multiple services
- single piece price
